VACs



All visa applications should be lodged in person or by mail to:

- New Zealand Visa Application Centre (NZ-VAC) – Jakarta or Bali

NZ-VACs do not provide immigration advice.

Working While Studying

- 20 hours per week
 - Full-time, at least two academic years - tertiary or PTE;
 - Full-time study for qualification for Skilled Migrant Category;
 - Full-time, secondary school, years 12 or 13, with permission of school and parents;
 - Full-time, at least 6 months, tertiary or PTE, primary purpose to develop English language skills AND minimum IELTS 5 no more than two years old.
- Christmas/New Year holiday period
 - Full-time, at least 12 months

Canterbury Work Rights

- Canterbury only
- Includes English Language students at least 14 weeks duration
- Level 4 foundation certificate, full-time, full year
- Category One providers only

- 20 hours per week

Essential Skills Work Visas

- Work visa are labour market tested - AIP or INZ test
- No NZ citizens or residents available
- Qualification relevant to job offer
- Meet health and character



Skills Shortages Lists (SSL)

- Immediate SSL (see next slides)
- Long Term SSL (see next slides)
- A list of occupations/skills in demand – the difference is in length of work visa
- Immediate SSL list may change from time to time, depending on demand for that skill
- Appropriate qualifications

ISSL: list of occupational groups

- Agriculture and Forestry
- Construction
- Education (post doctoral fellows)
- Engineering
- Finance/Business
- Health and Social Services



ISSL: list of occupational groups

- Oil and Gas
- Recreational and Hospitality/Tourism
- Science
- Trades
- Transport (truck driver – general)



LTSSL – list of occupational groups

- Same list as for Immediate SSL occupational groups
- Different occupations
- List is available on the website, or can be emailed out via Bill/Paul



Graduate Job Search Work Visa

- One year open work visa
- Meet qualifications requirement
- Apply no later than three months after end date of student visa
- Can only be granted once
 - Unless completing a 2nd, higher qualification at bachelor degree or post-graduate degree or higher
- Funds for maintenance (\$4200)

Qualification Requirements

Graduate Job Search

- NZ qualification for Skilled Migrant Category
- Level 7 or above for at least 1 year study in NZ
- Level 4 to 6, at least 2 years study in NZ
- Two NZ qualifications at level 4 to 6, each at least 1 year of study in NZ, 2nd qualification must be a higher level than the 1st (two years study in NZ in total)
- Instruction WD 1.10

Requirements:

Graduate Work Experience Visa

- Two year work visa, based on job offer
- Meet the qualification requirement, as per previous slide
- Offer of Employment relevant to the qualification
- Apply no later than 3 months after end date of student visa (except for doctoral degree – no later than 6 months), or
- Hold a graduate job search visa
- Completed work visa application and fee
- Employer supplementary form completed by employer



Work Visa for Partner

- Special work visa
- Partner of student
- Studying Level 7 or higher and,
- Specified in the Long Term Skills Shortage List (LTSSL); or,
- Post graduate qualifications.
- Minimum funds for maintenance apply

Dependent of Long Term Students



- Regarded as domestic students if parents are:
 - Studying under NZ Government approved exchange programme
 - Studying for PhD at NZ university
 - NZ Aid Scholarship holder.
- Otherwise, normal student instructions apply
- In all cases guarantee of accommodation and maintenance funds are required
- If other parent is holding open work visa, then the dependents are considered to be domestic students

Health Instructions

- Medical Certificates not required
- Chest X-Ray still required
- Medical insurance - arranged through education provider
- New application form
- Not PhD, or NZ Aid Sponsored, nor students classified as domestic students



Skilled Migrant Category

Designed to facilitate entry of skilled migrants with skills NZ needs and ability to successfully settle in NZ

Works on a points system – the selection point can change

Earn points for:

- Skilled job or skilled job offer in NZ
- Experience and qualifications
- Age and family situation

Process for Skilled Migrant Category

- Work out your points
- Submit Expression of Interest (EOI) into pool
- Selection from the pool
- Verification
- Invitation to Apply (ITA)
- Application for residence
- Verification and possible interview
- Residence decided

Process for Skilled Migrant Category

With points for a skilled job or job offer – likely to be selected

With points for work experience or qualifications in a skilled shortage area – may be selected if there are enough places available
